Yorkshire Water - Further visits and injection of dye have been carried out. Surface water removal is ineffective and a different contact person at Yorkshire Water advised the Chairman that they are awaiting approval via the Business Risk Model for money to be spent on work. .

Cllr Jones raised the question of what the parish council should do next as, despite the best efforts of the Chairman, who has given much time and effort to the matter, little forward progress has been made.
