## Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting 12th January 2021 via Zoom

### **20/061 Apologies for Absence and Declarations of Interest**

Cllr O Jones declared an interest in the planning application 20/02343/REM.

20/02343/REM Reserved matters application for the erection of three dwellings, Church Lane.

Councillors discussed this application and, whilst the council is not in opposition to this application in principle as it is within the local plan, the council does not wish to see any further development in the village until the ongoing issues relating to surface water, sewage and drainage have been resolved by Yorkshire Water.

### **20/068 Correspondence**

1. Thanks were received from the Recreation Association for the donation from the Parish Council.
2. The Clerk submitted her resignation to council and wishes to leave the post by 31st March 2021. An advert will be produced and circulated to secure a replacement.
3. A resident has enquired about the grit bins in the village. These should be refilled by NYCC so the Clerk will look into this.
4. There is a problem with overgrown shrubbery in the village encroaching on the paths and roadways. A note will be put in the newsletter to remind residents of their responsibility to keep pathways clear.
5. Concern was raised about vehicles driving over the village green near the bus stop to access the road. This is made worse by cars parked along the road at this point. The Council will request help from the Highways department before proceeding further with this matter.
