Cllr Atkinson advised that gritters were already on standby for the winter at a cost of £250,000 per week Superfast broadband is being rolled out across the council and the council is currently using the Magistrates Court in Northallerton, whilst repairs are carried out at county hall

A discussion around school transport took place. Cllr O Jones noted that requirement for education to continue past 16 is contradictory to the County Council policy that there is no requirement for them to pay for transport for over 16's. Cllr Atkinson advised that this is under review at NYCC and the deadline for this is December
